New Business:

- a) TXPSC – Denton
 - a. Contract for space Jan and April pending signatures – The number of hotel rooms for Wednesday night is being lowered. When that is completed, the contract will be ready to sign. They’re asking for us to sign an additional contract for January. There was some debate over the meeting space for January. Per the contract the Pat Howell room is 550 sq ft space and is the only available space for our Jan meetings. They wanted us to pay a \$800 food and beverage minimum to have a larger room. This needs to be adjusted in the next contract.
 - b. Decorator – signed for 3 years – IP Hall decorator has been signed for 3 years. It came in \$9,000 under budget.
 - c. Andy B’s signed – Costume contest will be at AndyB’s. Ayanna and JaCorey ware working on this.
 - d. Decorator for gala and AndyB’s - signed contracts as well.
 - e. Contract and payment for Shantelle Oliver – Lauren has sent Shantelle her check.
 - f. Awards

 - iii. Request for awards committee has gone out on PS Connect.
 - g. Tshirt contest
 - i. Announcement has been made. Deadline is December 15, so members need to share.
- b) National APCO San Antonio
 - a. Joint Chapter Night Out – Hotter than a summer’s night is the them. Jacorey Glaude sent an email with information. It will be August 2nd, 2026 from 6:30 pm – 10 pm at Smoke Sky Bar. The initial space has room for 600 people with an open bar, djs, mechanical bull, heavy appetizers. The space can hold 4,000 people. Additional guests after the 600 are \$53.40 per person. Estimated total for the event is \$32,041.50. So far, Georgia, Florida, Tennessee, Texas, and Virginia have pledged to give \$2500 toward the event. CCAMS are reaching out for sponsorships for the remaining. Each chapter has a

headcount of 100 people. We might need to revisit the numbers since it will be in Texas, we might have more attendees.

- b. Table? Board members agree to network and offer assistance and support for the conference instead of manning a table or booth.
- c) TXAPCO Website updated – Kristi has created a Wix website. Txapco.org is the Star Chapter domain. We do not own the domain and cannot transfer the info. The new website will be texasapco.com. All the Wix info will go to texasapco@gmail.com For \$90 more we secured the Wix website for 3 years. That included a 50% discount and purchase of the domain name, 2 additional years, ability for site info to be private so if someone goes on site registry, it does not have any personal info linked to website. The total amount for the Wix website for 3 years was \$619.40. Star chapter was over \$300/month.
- d) Board openings – Secretary, 2nd VP, Executive council will all be open come April. The candidates will send their declaration of candidacy and employer concurrence forms to Kristi. She will send the information to Tamara to be vetted. Tamara will notify Kristi when the candidates have been vetted, and then the candidates can campaign. The winners will be announced during the business meeting during the Texas Public Safety Conference.
