Divide the remaining donation amount by the total amount of TCs. Kristi will check with TXNENA to make sure they agree. Kristi is able to hand deliver gift cards to the TCs. TXPSC 2026 Denton – Kristi, Sofia, Maria, Tish, and Tulsi went through the last contract. The awards will be at the beginning of the conference. Kristi is waiting on the Embassy Suites to respond with what spaces they have open and get amendments to the contract. The walk through cannot happen on sept 15th due to the Embassy's schedule. The new proposed date is Oct 2nd.
